- \_\_\_\_\_ Every community should set aside land for cultivation of food.
- \_\_\_\_\_ At least ~60% of one's produce, milk and dairy should be grown within 200 miles of one's house.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Individuals have the right to build houses on private property as they see fit.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Communities should invest in taller, multi-family houses/buildings.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Communities should be able to use water resources that flow under/on their land without worrying about people/communities downstream.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Owning a home should be a goal of people living in America
- \_\_\_\_\_ Owning a single family home should be a goal of people living in America
- \_\_\_\_\_ Having shared open space should be a goal of people living in America
- \_\_\_\_\_ Having private outdoor space should be a goal of people living in America
- \_\_\_\_\_ Preserving wildlife refuges should be a goal of people living in America
- \_\_\_\_\_ Communities should be walkable
- \_\_\_\_\_ Owning a car should be a goal for most Americans
- \_\_\_\_\_ Parking a car in a public place should be relatively inexpensive
- \_\_\_\_\_ Communities should set aside funds to care for their trees
- \_\_\_\_\_ Communities should put limits on housing density in their area
- \_\_\_\_\_ Communities should be allowed to regulate how many unrelated individuals live in a single housing unit
